Many generations of Protectors have served as the peacekeepers and caretakers of the island of Okoto. Gathered around campfires, the Protectors recited the Prophecy of Heroes, which was first whispered to their ancestors by the sleeping body of Ekimu the Mask Maker after a devastating and historic battle with his evil brother, Makuta.

When times are dark and all hope seems lost, The Protectors must unite. One from each tribe, Evoke the power of past and future And look to the skies for an answer. When the stars align, Six comets will bring timeless heroes To claim the masks of power And find the Mask Maker. United, the elements hold the power to defeat evil. United but not one.

HIRERS HAKERS

Thousands of years ago, the brothers Ekimu and Makuta, known as the Mask Makers, used the elemental forces of the island of Okoto to create masks of power for the islanders. The islanders used their masks of power to shape their island, transforming it into a fantastic place full of wonders and beautiful landscapes.

The Mask Makers possessed special masks. Ekimu had the Mask of Creation, and Makuta had the Mask of Control. Although the brothers produced many masks, the islanders especially treasured the mask made by Ekimu. Makuta

became envious of his brother's popularity, and came up with a treacherous plan to create the most powerful mask ever.

Although the Mask Makers knew that masks with more than one elemental power were extremely dangerous and difficult to control, Makuta channeled the island's six elements into a single mask, which he called the Mask of Ultimate Power. When Makuta put the mask on, its power

overwhelmed him, and the island began to shake and crumble.



Once a paradise full of great forests and brimming with life, the island of Okoto was forever changed by the explosion of the Mask of Ultimate Power during the battle of the Mask Makers. The tremendous energy unleashed by the explosion destroyed the island's great cities and transformed Okoto into an island with six distinct regions, characterized by ice, water, jungle, fire, earth, and stone. Only the southern jungles, protected from the blast by the lee of the mountains, escaped the cataclysm.

Once the site of a great capital built by Okoto's ancient civilization, and also the site of the battle of the Mask Makers, the Great Crater was formed by the explosion caused by the Mask of Ultimate Power.





Perched on the peak of a small mountain on the eastern side of Okoto, between the Region of Water and the Region of Jungle, the Temple of Time is the Protectors' most sacred place. The Protectors believe the Temple of Time is the oldest structure on the entire island, and it is among the few structures that escaped destruction during the battle of the Mask Makers. The Protectors also believe



that the temple mystically connects Okoto with other places, including distant worlds, across time and space. When the Protectors finally realize that their own powers are not sufficient to stop the rising evil on Okoto, they go to the Temple of Time to recite the Prophecy of Heroes and summon the Toa.

LIMPSKOF TIME

Kept in a secret vault in the Temple of Time, the Mask of Time possesses powers that even the wisest elders don't

completely understand. According to ancient legends, the Mask of Time is actually a fragment of a larger mask: It is the upper half that completes the true Mask of Time.

The Protectors do not possess any

records or illustrations regarding the lower half of the Mask of Time and are unaware of its location.



Six Protectors, one from each regional tribe on Okoto, are tasked with helping to guide the six Toa on their quests. The Protectors wear sacred Elemental Masks that have been passed down through many generations. Each carries uniquely personal weapons that were engineered for optimal use in their home regions. Because of their duties and the vastness of their island, the six Protectors rarely gather in the same location at the same time.

Protector of Ice


Name: Izotor

Weapons: Elemental ice blaster, ice saw

Protector of Water

Name: Kivoda

Weapons: Elemental torpedo blaster, two propulsion turbines





Delivered by comets to the island of Okoto, the six Toa are timeless heroes who respectively represent the island's six elemental forces: ice, water, jungle, fire, earth, and stone. Where they came from or who sent them remains a mystery, but their arrival was anticipated by the ancient Prophecy of Heroes, which foretold that they would come and save Okoto in a time of darkness.

Master of Ice

Name: Kopaka

Weapons: Ice spear, frost shield, avalanche skis

Master of Water

Name: Gali

Weapons: Harpoon, elemental trident, shark fins





An evil-eyed, six-legged creature, the monstrous

Lord of Skull Spiders patrols and guards the bridge to
the ancient City of the Mask Makers. As his name implies,
the Lord of Skull Spiders controls all the Skull Spiders,
using a telepathic link to make them locate and steal every
mask they can find. The Lord of Skull Spiders spits sticky
webbing at his enemies and is also the master of a powerful
death-lock attack that can squeeze the air out of even the
toughest hero.



SKULL SPIDERS

When four-legged Skull Spiders lock on to a victim's head, they possess the victim's mind, transforming the victim into a slave of the Lord of Skull Spiders. Although victims can be rescued if an ally knocks the spider off his or her head, and although the Protectors have mastered many fighting techniques to subdue the spiders, the spiders remain a terrible threat to the islanders on Okoto.

Blue Skull Spiders

Notoriously tough, blue Skull Spiders are not easily crushed by heavy weights or hard impacts.



Green Skull Spiders

Having developed X-ray vision, green Skull Spiders can find prey in total darkness.



Silver Skull Spiders

A subspecies of the Skull Spiders, silver Skull Spiders are the fastest.

Crafted by Ekimu the Mask Maker, the six Golden
Masks of Power were among the many masks that became
scattered all over the island during Ekimu's explosive battle
with his evil brother, Makuta. The Protectors recovered the
